Mary Portrait Prayer Art

The Mary Portrait Template measurement: 11x17 inches

Instructions:

Step One: Print out each sheet as a single sheet on 11x17 card stock.

Step Two: Glue the portrait of Mary and Jesus to the non-sequential template (4-3-2-1). Glue them back to back. Be sure that 4-3-2-1 is on the top, closest to Mary's head on the opposite side. SPRAY GLUE is the most effective way to glue the two sheets together. Its best to have a very tight seal throughout the two sheets.

Step Three: Once the glued sheets are fully dry, cut up the sheets along the box lines. The margins do not need to be trimmed. Leave them as they are. When you are finished you should have 21 separate boxes.

Step Four: Have students write their prayers to Mary on the white/numbered side of the boxes.

When the students are writing, the number should appear on the upper left corner of the box.

I want to pray for my mom.

Step Five: Hang the sequential template paper (1-2-3-4) on a wall. Have students use glue sticks and apply glue directly over the prayer they wrote to Mary. Yes that is right, apply glue to the side that they just wrote on. Glue stick is best here as Elmer's Glue can bubble through the margins if too much is used.

Step Six: Have students come up one at a time and glue their piece to the corresponding box on the template hanging on the wall. The number on the student's piece should be glued on the top line of the corresponding box.
