

Science Reveals the Power of Prayer!

- There is a 7-year difference in life expectancy between those who never attend church and those who attend weekly.
- A study of nearly 4,000 older adults for the U.S. Journal of Gerontology revealed that atheists had a significantly increased chance of dying over a six-year period than the faithful.
- Research at San Francisco General Hospital looked at the effect of prayer on 393 cardiac patients. Half were prayed for by strangers who had only the patients' names. Those patients had fewer complications, fewer cases of pneumonia, and needed less drug treatment. They also healed more quickly and left the hospital earlier.






Simple Structure for Spontaneous Prayer: ACTS Adoration Confession Thanksgiving Supplication






If you want to reach people, start by talking with them about what they worry about and what they celebrate, and speak in the images and language of the people you want to reach.
